▶ The Challenge

LACK OF STATE FUNDING - The District did **NOT** receive any increase in state funding on a per-student basis in **6 of the last 10 years.**

LOW REVENUE LIMITS - Deerfield's revenue limit per student is the <u>lowest</u> among neighboring school districts and at the <u>lowest</u> level in the state.

COVID-19 FUNDS ENDED - Federal funding that helped bridge the deficit in state funding has ended.

VOTER APPROVED FUNDING EXPIRES SOON - The voter-approved 2020 referendum expires June 30, 2025.

▶ The Need

- ◆ Revenue to support curriculum purchases, technology, subscription fees and classroom supplies
- Revenue to support rising daily operation expenses such as disposable supplies, utilities, and service contracts
- ◆ Revenue to attract and retain quality staff and maintain current student services and programs
