Lack of State Funding—Our fixed expenses continue to rise while state funding has not kept pace with inflation. The District did **NOT** receive an increase in state funding on a per-student basis in 6 of the last 10 years.

\$300,000	\$6.25	\$75

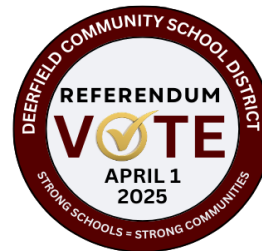
